

THE 15TH REGIS CLASSIC TOUR –
“TO THE PEAKS OF PERFECTION”
Visiting Derbyshire Dales and The Peak District

Friday 30th, Saturday 31st March and Sunday 1st April 2011

Deposits have been coming in thick and fast for the 15th Regis Classic Tour 2012 visiting the Peak District. Our chosen host hotel is set in a leafy suburb, within 1 mile of the city centre, the 4* Kenwood Hall Hotel on the eastern side of Sheffield should fit the bill perfectly. Situated in 12 acres of landscaped grounds with a lake and ample secure parking, the hotel is about 3 miles from the Peak District and wonderful scenery. www.principal-hayley.com/locations/kenwood-hall.aspx. The hotel has a leisure centre with pool, gym & hair dressing salon. The recce team received a very warm welcome and feel the hotel will fit our needs very well.



The event is again raising funds for Against Breast Cancer & Orchid – Fighting Male Cancer – to date the previous 14 Regis Classic Tours, all organised by the Ladies of Bognor Regis Motor Club have raised £316,117.63 for Cancer charities. A record breaking £36,506.48 was raised from the 14th Tour to North Devon and Somerset and the charities still have to calculate the Gift Aid which will increase this figure still further.

The venues for 2012 have now been chosen:

Saturday morning the route heads south from Kenwood Hall Hotel through the Peak District to Tissington to take in the famous Ford with a visit to this historic village and a mini Hall tour with Sir Richard Fitzherbert followed by coffee and cake. www.tissingtonhall.co.uk. From there a short and picturesque route leads to the Middleton Top Engine House where crews will have the opportunity to see this magnificent beam engine in action. www.derbyshire.gov.uk/countryside/leisure.

A light Lunch will be taken at Carsington Water www.moretoexperience.co.uk before the route returns northwards through the Manifold Valley with another brief stop for a chance to hear and see the infamous “Pipes in the Peaks” www.pipesinthepeaks.co.uk. Afternoon cream tea will be served at The Stables Restaurant, in picturesque Eyam www.eyamhall.co.uk known as The Plague Village before returning to Kenwood Hall.

The usual Drinks Reception, Sparking Gala Dinner, Grand Auction and Tombola takes place on Saturday evening with live entertainment to dance to until the early hours. Already several wonderful prizes have been donated for the auction including: A weekend break at Kenwood Hall Hotel, A limited edition print by Alfredo de la Maria signed by Sir Stirling Moss, A Devon and Somerset Break with one night at Millers at the Anchor at Porlock Weir

and one night at Northcote Manor Hotel, both luxury accommodation in Devon, with other items in the pipe-line to follow.

Sunday morning the route heads west to Gawsorth Hall www.gawsworthhall.co.uk for morning coffee and home-made cake and mini visit around this amazing hall and gardens. The route then takes crews back into the Peak District National Park before heading out again to the finish at the delightful Adlington Hall. www.adlingtonhall.com.

Traditionally the tour finishes after lunch on Sunday, allowing those needing to head home to leave. However, a good number of participants tend to extend their stay and book an additional night at the hotel. The Sunday evening optional trip has become another “must do” part of the event. The proposed plan for next year is a coach trip out to Victoria Quay and an evening boat trip on the Tinsley and Sheffield Canal 1819 with a “Pie and Pea Supper” www.sheffieldboats.co.uk.

The event is a non-competitive weekend classic tour visiting a different part of the country each year. You do not need to be a club member or have a competition licence to take part.
